E. INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS:

This product has the following installation instructions:

INSTALL STEP	INSTRUCTIONS
1. MIXING	Mix the colorant immediately before beginning the project. Shake colorant container thoroughly to mix pigment.
2. APPLICATION	Add GacoRoof Colorant to a 1 gallon or 5-gallon pail of GacoRoof White. Mix thoroughly with a mechanical mixer, scrape the sides of the pail and then mix again.
3. CLEAN UP	Application tools and equipment can be cleaned with GacoFlex Silicone Solvent or 100% Pure Mineral Spirits. DO NOT USE WATER OR RECLAIMED SOLVENTS.
